

Color Kicker:



A palette of warm neutrals, as restful as evening's approach, this muted selection of opal and transparent glass is stable and dependable. Most of these colors will stay pretty true after firing. Light bronze in the cold sheet? Light bronze once fired.

Want some sparkle? Add a metallic accent. The Light Silver Gray, Bronze and Violet glasses are all available with an iridescent coating.

Still more choices

We've used the thin, 1.6mm, glass for the color parts of our Kicker tile, but for additional variations in saturation, consider using more 3mm glass.

For texture and surface interest, you might include frits, stringers and confetti in your designs. See what's available in the chart below:

This one's a soft KICKER. A gentle violet, 1428, when layered over your other colors will mute and harmonize them.

If you start to snooze off, add an accent of black to this palette and awaken the sophisticate.


DUSK is a palette that transitions easily from end-of-day ease to nighttime energy.




We created our tile using 3 layers of Bullseye Compatible glass:

- · A base of thin (-50) colors and clear
- · A center layer of thin (-50) color and clear
- · A top solid layer of standard clear 1101-30

This total thickness (6.2mm) should not flow out or shrink appreciably when fired to a full fuse. If you are stacking higher, use dams to maintain your original footprint.
